Magnolia Bostad signs cooperation agreement with Västerkulla Hotell

The agreement was signed March 14th, and implies that Västerekulla Hotell Holding AB has the possibility of acquiring hotels developed by Magnolia Bostad. Västerkulla Hotell is owned by the Swedish Trade Union Confederation (LO) and The Foundation for Baltic and East European Studies (Östersjöstiftelsen).
